COMBINED CLUB TEAMS POLICY

The intent of this initiative is to encourage members of developing or less competitive clubs to remain within the club for competition purposes and to encourage developing or less competitive clubs to be involved in surf sports.

Each competitor will be representing their own club in the Combined Club Team. At events where points are on offer their club will receive the respective apportionment of points.

The following requirements will be in place:

1. Combined Club Teams consisting of competing members from more than one club must fulfill all SLSA and SLSWA entry requirements for competition.
2. Competitors can change club combinations between events but not within events. Once a combined team is entered those clubs will be represented in that team, another club cannot be substituted.
3. A club with sufficient competitors entered in an event to constitute a team cannot combine with another club.

Any combined club teams formed must fall within the intent of this policy. Please note that the Carnival Referee holds the final discretion as to whether a combined club team entry will be accepted.

CONTINGENCY FOR VENUE

Reserve venues have been selected for the event subject to both conditions and council approvals. The Referee will review the proposed venue Saturday morning before the event. On the occasion that the venue must be changed SLSWA will contact the nominated Team Manager from each entered club at latest by 4pm on the Saturday.

OFFICIALS

The ratio of 1 Official per 5 competitors applies to the 2009 IRB Rescue Championships. Clubs are requested to identify their participating Officials on the Entry Form

For the IRB State Championships the above events will carry points towards the 2009 Surf Champions Banner, which is awarded to the Club with the highest aggregate pointscore for the 2009 WA Senior Surf Life Saving Championships

For any event to be contested at the WA Surf Life Saving Championships, a minimum of three (3) starters from three (3) separate clubs is required.

ENTRY FEES

State Series Fees

- \$15 per person
- Clubs will be invoiced accordingly for entry fees at the conclusion of each round

State Championships

- Entry conditions will be as per the respective Championship Bulletins.
- Entry Fees are \$35.00 per person.
- Clubs will be invoiced accordingly for entry fees at the conclusion of the 2009 WA IRB Surf Life Saving Championships.
- Entry fees are non-refundable if members do not take part in these Championships or if events are subsequently cancelled after commencement of the Championships.

ENTRY CONDITIONS

- For the IRB Series and the IRB State Championships please use the Entry Form attached to this document.
- Entries provided via post / fax on the attached Entry Form.
- Entries will close 5pm Wednesday before each event.
- Entry conditions will be as per the respective Championship Bulletins.
- NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED.
- A Club Executive Officer must sign the declaration advising the proficiency and patrol hour aspects of all competitors on the entry forms are in accordance with the requirements of their membership categories.
