Summary:

An IRB Practical Driver Assessment has been scheduled for July, August, September, October and November 2008. Clubs wishing to take part in any assessment must notify SLSWA. IRB Assessors wishing to remain current and participate in IRB assessments must contact John King.

Action:

Clubs to provide details of IRB driver candidates to SLSWA or John King **at least 7 days prior** to the commencement of the assessment.

Due to many requests for IRB driver assessment sessions, SLSWA has scheduled the following opportunities over the coming months. The theory section of the assessment will be conducted prior to the practical assessment at a time and location decided upon when candidate numbers are known.

8.00am Saturday	19th July	–	Secret Harbour SLSC
8:00am Saturday	16th August	–	Scarboro SLSC
8.00am Sunday	28st September	–	Scarboro SLSC
8:00am Saturday	11th October	–	Scarboro SLSC
7.30am Saturday	22nd November	–	Scarboro SLSC

Clubs are required to enter an assessment request onto SurfGuard and confirm with John King at SLSWA, at least 7 days prior to the commencement of the assessment. The candidates must have completed their training and a trial assessment prior to the scheduled assessment date. Drivers cannot be submitted for an assessment until the Crew Award has been completed and lodged in SurfGuard.

IRB Assessors are required for the above dates and throughout the “off season”. Any IRB Assessor who is able to help with assessments and wishes to remain current are requested to contact John King by email.

Clubs are to ensure their candidates have undergone the appropriate training and have logged this correctly, as this evidence is required at the assessment.
