Travel & Accommodation

SLSWA will provide:

- Up to three air tickets respectively for Esperance Goldfields and Broome SLSC will be organised by the country delegates by contacting Amanda Deurloo from Travel World on 08 9221 9960 by no later than Tuesday 23rd December 2008.
- Fuel allowances will be paid to country club delegates as following:
 - Albany-Denmark-Geraldton-Champion Bay-Dongara Denison-Margaret River fuel allowance capped at \$225 per car. (Maximum of two cars).
 - City of Bunbury, Dalyellup and Binningup fuel allowance capped at \$150 per car. (Maximum of two cars).
 - Port Bouvard, Secret Harbour, Mandurah fuel allowance capped at \$70 per car. (Maximum of two cars).
- An accommodation subsidy of \$90 per person for the Friday night prior to the meetings will be provided for 1 country delegate attending each meeting, ie the subsidy will be for a maximum of 4 people per club

(excluding Port Bouvard, Secret Harbour and Mandurah). Where unique circumstances apply (eg a flight cannot be arranged for Saturday afternoon) we will also provide the same subsidy for the Saturday night. Please note that this subsidy is based on 50% of a twin share room at the Best Western Emerald Hotel in the Perth CBD.

We have taken on board feedback received from delegates in respect to the inflexibility of having their accommodation arranged for them in previous years, individual delegates will now be responsible for arranging their own accommodation. To assist club delegates in arranging accommodation we recommend the Best Western Emerald Hotel, they can be contacted on 9481 0866.

To receive their subsidy clubs are to invoice SLSWA by not later than 31st January 2009 attaching copies of relevant receipts.
