SLSWA is offering an opportunity to attend a course in Basic Beach Management or what used to be the Patrol Captains course. This course is essential for existing and incumbent Patrol Captains that do not yet hold an award in this area.

This course is approximately seven hours of contact time and this would be determined by the size of the groups and the level of interaction of the workshop activities. It is desirable to have a number of different clubs participate in each course session to get the best outcome from the discussion groups and for effective control of time it will be restricted to 24 candidates per course session.
