CHECKLIST

The following checklist has been designed to assist Club Competition Officers complete the necessary entry requirements for members wishing to compete at the 2010 Country Club Surf Lifesaving Championships.

1. INFORMATION:

Ensure all the information contained in this document has been read thoroughly and the conditions for entries have been adhered to.

2. ENTRIES

On-line Entries

Entries for WA Surf Lifesaving Championships will be available on www.mybeach.com.au from the 20th January 2010.

Upon completion of the above, the following is to be undertaken:

- Endorse entries – through completion of the online process
- It is the responsibility of the club to ensure the eligibility of members. Random eligibility checks will be undertaken by SLSWA.
- Clubs will be invoiced for entry fees.

3. DECLARATION:

Attached declaration to be completed.

4. READ CAREFULLY:

Penalties – Breach of Entry Regulations

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NOTE II: Clubs who have outstanding financial debts with SLSWA exceeding more than 90 days will not be eligible to enter the Championships, until that debt is cleared or on approval from the Chief Executive Officer.

PART D: COMMERCIAL AND OTHER IDENTIFICATION ON “APPAREL & EQUIPMENT”

Part A: EVENTS

These championships will be conducted in accordance with the Rules and Regulations of the SLSA Surf Sports Manual 33rd Edition and subsequent amendments.

- For any event to be contested at the WA Surf Life Saving Championships, a minimum of three (3) starters from two (2) separate clubs is required.
- All Taplin Relays (incl open) 3 person only.
- All Mixed Teams require a minimum of one female competitor.
- All Surf Teams will be 4 persons.
- Composite Teams will be accepted.
- The All Age Beach Relay is restricted to one team per club.

Part B - ENTRY CONDITIONS

B1 PROFICIENCY

Proficiency requirements for all competitions have been outlined in SLSA Policy number 5.4 Proficiency & Patrol HR Requirements – Comp Eligibility (Nov 2009). This document has been forwarded to all WA clubs and can be located on the SLSA website at the following address:

B2 PATROL REQUIREMENTS FOR COMPETITORS

Patrol Hour requirements for all competitions have been outlined in SLSA Policy number 5.4 Proficiency & Patrol HR Requirements – Comp Eligibility (Nov 2009). This document has been forwarded to all WA clubs and can be located on the SLSA website at the following address:

B3 SPONSOR IDENTIFICATION

It is also a condition of entry to the Championships that competitors may be required to carry sponsors logos/identification on craft, boats and equipment. However, if this occurs every effort will be made not to cover other signage, provided it does not conflict with the naming right sponsor of the Championships. For further information on sponsorship, refer to SLSA Competition Sponsorship Policy, accessible on the SLSA website.

B4 RESTRICTIONS & PROVISOS

- (a) All events shall be contested by teams and individuals representing clubs.
- (b) All team entry sheets will be required to be lodged with the Marshall. Any withdrawal or replacement of a competitor or team shall be notified in writing to the Marshall by the representative of the Club.

PART C: ENTRIES

C1 ENTRY CLOSURE

- (a) By entering using the online entry system the club declares that the proficiency and patrol hour aspects of all competitors on the entry forms are in accordance with the requirements of their membership categories. The Club Officer must also complete Appendix A – Declaration Form and return to SLSWA by close of entries. This should be faxed to 9243 9499.
- (b) Any entries received after the closing date will be considered as late entries.

C2 LATE ENTRIES

- (a) Late entries will not be accepted after 11pm, Wednesday 10th February 2010.
- (b) Late entries will be charged the normal entry fee plus the late entry fee of \$18.00 per senior competitor. The Club will be invoiced accordingly.
- (c) **Late entries of new members gaining their respective awards after the closing date of entries will not be accepted.**

C3 ENTRIES

- (a) Entries must be registered with SLSWA by close of entries listing all competitors, including the "Handlers only". The online entry system will provide a separate event class, 'Equipment Handler', where club members acting only as handlers can be entered in the carnival at no cost (the club will not be invoiced for handlers). Handlers competing in other events should enter the carnival as per other competitors and will be invoiced accordingly. Handlers are required to be a current financial member of the Club, as outlined in the SLSA Surf Sports Manual 33rd Edition 8.2.1 (c).
- (b) Membership Classifications
 - Open – O
 - Under 19 – U19
 - Under 17 – U17
 - Under 15 – U15
- (c) Each competitor entered must have completed a proficiency test and this must be detailed in the entries.

C4 ENTRY FEES

- (a) The cost per senior and junior competitor entered in these Championships is \$18.00 each, irrespective of the number of events entered.
- (b) There is no cost for Handlers only entered in these Championships.
- (c) Clubs will be invoiced accordingly for entry fees.
- (d) Entry fees are non-refundable if members do not take part in these Championships or if events are subsequently cancelled after commencement of the Championships.
- (e) All prices outlined in this Bulletin include GST.

C5 DECLARATION

- (a) It is a condition of entry that by using the online entry system that clubs declare that the competitors entered are financial, proficient and satisfy the patrol requirements as detailed in this document, and the entries are in all other ways in accordance with Association and Club regulations. The Club Officer must also complete Appendix A – Declaration Form and return to SLSWA by close of entries. This should be faxed to 9243 9499.

C6 COMPETITION CONDITIONS

- (a) Competition conditions for all events not expressed in this Bulletin are set out in the 33rd Edition SLSA Competition Manual and any subsequent Bulletins.

C7 PENALTIES – BREACH OF ENTRY REGULATIONS

It is mandatory that ALL competitors are listed in the Club's entry.

Entry of competitors who are ineligible due to non qualification or proficiency, default of personal patrol hour obligations, or other breach of association or club entry regulations have penalties provided for as follows:

THE PENALTY FOR BREACH OF ENTRY REGULATIONS FOR THE 2010 WA COUNTRY SURF LIFE SAVING CHAMPIONSHIPS WILL BE THE AUTOMATIC REJECTION OF ENTRIES FOR THOSE PERSONS FOUND TO BE IN BREACH OF REGULATIONS AND THE FORFEITURE OF THEIR ENTRY FEES.

APPLICATION OF THE AUTOMATIC PENALTY WILL NOT PRECLUDE FURTHER DISCIPLINARY ACTION BY THE ASSOCIATION AGAINST CLUBS OR OTHER PERSONS IF DEEMED APPROPRIATE IN THE CASE OF SERIOUS ATTEMPTS TO DEFEAT ASSOCIATION REGULATIONS.

PART D: COMMERCIAL AND OTHER IDENTIFICATION ON "APPAREL AND EQUIPMENT"

The Chief Executive Officer or his representative, Chief Referee and Sectional Referees, reserve the right to enforce the following from the SLSA Sponsorship Policy at the 2010 WA Country Surf Life Saving Championships.

No competitor, handler and / or Club is permitted to have any sign writing, logos or corporate ID on either clothing, competition apparel, gear, equipment or on the person in the competition arena (including marshalling and presentation areas) which is deemed not in "good taste".

At the conclusion of events, place getters may be offered items of apparel (t-shirt etc) identified with the sponsor, which they may be asked to wear during the presentation of medals. Every cooperation is requested in this regard and members should keep in mind that the involvement of sponsor's help to curtail significant expenses that would otherwise need to be passed onto competitors and clubs.

- (a) No competitor shall be required to carry either the carnival naming rights or individual event sponsors identification on lycras, except where specified below (Note 1). Competitors will be required to carry sponsors logos / identification on craft/boats/ equipment and body (tattoos) except where specified below (Note 2). Where physically possible, no signage will be covered.

NOTE I: All competitors in Championship events may be asked to wear naming right sponsor's lycra's.

NOTE II: Those craft/persons with rival sponsors to the carnival/event naming right sponsor will not be required to display the carnival/event naming right sponsors signage and/or to cover the rival sponsor's signage.

(b) CRAFT & EQUIPMENT

BOARDS

The front deck of boards will be the event sponsors signage area where a 33cm X 33cm (approx.) decal, etc, may be placed and the remainder of the surface area will be the owners.

SKIS

The front deck of skis will be the event sponsors signage area where a 33cm X 33cm (approx.) decal, etc, may be placed and the remainder of the surface area will be the owners.

SURF BOATS

A space 150cm X 30cm above the waterline on both sides of the boat.

If the designated spaces are not available or practical due to existing signage, then the naming rights/event sponsors signage will be placed on any suitable alternative spaces.

(c) UNIFORMS

LYCRA SINGLETS / FULL COSTUMES

A club can display its own sponsors signage, once only, in a space not exceeding 15cm X 15cm.

FULL COSTUMES

In this context, means women's costumes or R&R and March Past costumes. Again a club sponsor may be displayed once only in an area not exceeding 15cm X 15cm.

MALE COSTUMES

Club sponsors can be shown once only on an area on the costumes not exceeding 15cm X 5cm.

(d) MARCH PAST BANNERS

Club sponsors can be shown once only on the banner in an area not exceeding 25cm X 25cm.

(e) BODY TATTOOS

Club sponsors can be shown once only on the body and limbs not exceeding 15cm X 5cm.
