A Dulux Representative will contact you within five working days to arrange a visit to your club. Once there they will assess your building, work out how much paint you'll need and discuss preparation and painting.

We will also offer you a complimentary, one-hour consultation, with a Colour Consultant to help you choose the right colours. To arrange, simply call us on 13 25 25 and let us know your Club name.

You can make your final order through your Dulux Representative, at which point you will also need to confirm your colour choices and council approval.

Paint collection will be at a Dulux stockist in your area, as advised by your Dulux Representative.

# THE REPAINT PROCESS

This is a guide on the steps you'll be working through.

 <p><b>PREPARATION</b></p>	<p>Correct preparation is vital to ensure the best result for long lasting protection – such as cleaning, removing peeling or flaking paint or repairing the surfaces.</p> <p>Your Dulux Representative will help you work out how much preparation is needed for exterior surfaces.</p> <p>To assist you in getting your club paint ready, see common problems and solutions at <a href="http://www.dulux.com.au/advice/paint-problem-solver">www.dulux.com.au/advice/paint-problem-solver</a></p> <p>Depending on the condition of your club you may need to organise some professional assistance.</p> <p>For example during the recent Tamarama SLSC repaint the building required filling in of cracks prior to painting.</p>
 <p><b>HOW MUCH PAINT WILL YOU NEED?</b></p>	<p>You are entitled up to 100 litres per year until September 2014. But how much paint you need varies and can be assessed and agreed with your Dulux Representative.</p>
 <p><b>COLOURS</b></p>	<p>Choosing colour is often a collaborative decision. To help, we've created a range of coastal colour palettes. Also enclosed are some colour brochures. You can also view more colour schemes at <a href="http://dulux.com.au">dulux.com.au</a></p> <p>Your club is also entitled to a one-hour complimentary consultancy (depending on their availability in your area).</p> <p>To arrange, simply call us on 13 25 25 and let us know your Club name.</p>
 <p><b>COUNCIL APPROVAL</b></p>	<p>Just a reminder your local council needs to approve any new colour scheme. Please contact your local council to check any other requirements for your area.</p>
 <p><b>SOURCING YOUR PAINT</b></p>	<p>Paint collection will be at a Dulux stockist in your area, as advised by your Dulux Representative.</p>
 <p><b>PAINTING</b></p>	<p>Depending on your Club, you may either need to hire a local Trade Painter to handle the project for you, or you may be organising the repaint yourselves.</p> <p>Please ensure you work through all insurance cover and safety assurances with your council.</p> <p>You may also need to organise different types of equipment and scaffolding to get the paint job done.</p>
 <p><b>CLEAN-UP</b></p>	<p>Dulux Waste Paint Hardener turns unwanted water-based paints into solid waste for easy disposal.</p> <p>Contact your Dulux Representative if you are interested in using this for left over-paint.</p> <p>Please refer to the back of the Weathershield can for tips on the best ways to clean-up.</p>
