## Carnival format explanation... something for everyone

### ^ Points Series Carnivals

- Generously sponsored by Shane Bowler, these carnivals will count towards points for the prestigious 'trophy mugs' for Open Male and Open Female categories.
- Crews will be awarded points for attendance and placings.
- U19 and U23 male & female finals will be held at the start of each of these carnivals.
- Format for Open Male and Female categories will be heats for points to progress to A & B finals.

### \* State Team Series Carnivals

- Subject to SLSWA's policy on selecting representative teams, this carnival series will assist SLSWA determine the State team to represent Western Australia at the ASRL Open Inter-State Championship on Friday 18 February 2022 at Elouera Beach, NSW.
- Placings for crews in each Qualifying Carnival will be considered when SLSWA invites crews to the Selection Carnival. To be likely to be invited to the Selection Carnival, crews would have to place in the top three of their category in at least one of the Qualifying Carnivals.
- Finals of the U19 and U23 Male and Female categories will be held at the start of each Qualifying Carnival. U19 and U23 crews may also enter the Open category of each Qualifying Carnival.
- Carnival format for crews vying for selection as the Open and Reserve Male and Female State representatives will be:
  - o **Qualifying Carnival 1** – all male and female crews to race in the same category during heats to progress to A & B finals. Placings in A finals will be considered for invitations to 'Division A' of the Selection Carnival.
  - o **Qualifying Carnivals 2 & 3** – crews are to nominate before the carnival whether they wish to race in:
    - 'Division A', racing 4-5 rounds for points, where their placing will be considered for invitations to the Selection Carnival; or
    - 'Division B', where crews will race in heats to progress to a final of the division, but their placing will not be considered for invitations to the Selection Carnival.
  - o **Selection Carnival**
    - 'Division A' – U19, U23 and Open Male and Female crews who have been invited to race for State Team selection will race 4-5 rounds for points, where:
      - Winners of the U19 and U23 Male and Female categories will be appointed as the State Team Representatives for those categories; and
      - Winners and Runners Up of the Open Male and Female categories will be appointed as the State Team Representatives for the Open and Reserve categories respectively.
    - 'Division B' – Open Male and Female categories will be offered for crews who were not invited to race for State Selection.
