Parking

Competition requirements

Under 8 – Minimum of 7 years old with U8 Junior Competition Skills evaluation.

Under 9 - Minimum of 8 years old with U9 Junior Competition Skills evaluation.

Please ensure Woodside Nippers hi-vis vests and club caps are worn to this event.

Clubs are responsible to ensure that their Woodside Nippers have the required Junior Competition skills evaluation. Those Woodside Nippers without the Competition Skills evaluation can only participate in beach events.

QMSLSC strongly suggests that all competitors come equipped with a wide brimmed hat, long sleeved shirt, a full water bottle and appropriate sun cream.

Officials

Officials and Marshalls will be provided and sourced by the QMSLSC Lead official. Morning tea and refreshments will be provided in the Officials' tent. Can we thank all officials from all clubs who have volunteered to support this event.

Water Safety

Clubs are required to provide 1 Water Safety person per 10 competitors. Water Safety Personnel need a minimum qualification of a proficient Nipper Rescue Certificate, Surf Rescue Certificate or Bronze Medallion. All rostered clubs are required to supply a rescue tube and orange cap/vest for their water safety members.

QMSLSC will be providing additional water safety via IRB, RWC and in-water personnel.

Water Safety personnel from the rostered Clubs need to meet the carnival Water Safety Coordinator at the water marshalling point between the water arenas prior to their session start time so they can sign on and be assigned roles.

Briefings

These will be held at 7.30am.

Age Manager briefing – Between the two water arenas.

Officials and Marshalls– QSLSC Function/Bar Area.

Marshalling

Age Managers are to ensure that Woodside Nippers are ready and prepared for marshalling. This will allow the carnival to run to its intended timelines.

Please support the Marshall by briefing Little Nippers on the importance of listening and staying in the designated lines they are placed in. Parents and spectators are to remain outside the arenas.

Place boards to the left side of the marshalling tents that you will be competing in.

Age Managers are responsible for bringing boards to competitors once they are lined up by the Marshall.

No competitor numbers or wristbands are required as there will not be heats or qualifying in the Surf, Board or Sprint races. All participants will be involved in one race at a minimum, additional races will be decided on the day as seen fit by the carnival organisers and officials.

Flag competitors will be knocked out at a rate decided by the official in the flag arena.

Sportsmanship

Please ensure that all Woodside Nippers, parents, and volunteers are briefed on the expectations in this area. All must respect the officials' decisions and support ALL Woodside Nippers from all clubs in their efforts. Clubs are responsible for the conduct of their Woodside Nippers, parents, and volunteers.

QMSLSC want to acknowledge the volunteers from all clubs that have been involved in both the preparation and delivery of this carnival. Your time, effort and sportsmanship are appreciated.
