The 2022 Surf Life Saving WA IRB Championships are being held at Scarborough Beach on Saturday 18 June 2022, with events starting at 8am.

Medals and Presentations

Medals will be presented directly after the conclusion of all events on the central grassed area outside of the Scarborough SLSC clubrooms.

For any event to be contested at the 2022 Surf Life Saving WA IRB Championships, a minimum of three (3) teams from (2) different clubs are required.

As such, for all events, medals will be awarded as follows:

- (a) Three (3) or more competitors – Gold, Silver and Bronze Medals may be awarded.

The 2022 *Surf Life Saving WA IRB Champion Club* banner will be presented to the Club with the highest overall points score from the results of the Championships.

Safety Requirements

There will be random checks throughout the day conducted by the Carnival Referee or delegated scrutineer.

Protests

All protests shall be lodged with the appropriate sectional referee in accordance with the procedures set down in the SLSA Surf Sports Manual 37th Edition, section 14 – PROTESTS, APPEALS AND DISCIPLINE and shall identify the specific sections/clauses in the Competition Manual upon which the protest is based. A fee of \$220.00 will be charged to lodge a protest or appeal.

Entry Information

Entries will close 11.59pm Wednesday 15 June 2022 with no late entries accepted.

Entries are \$40 per competitor and are to be paid online through SurfTec - www.mybeach.com.au/entries. Clubs are to create their teams from their entered athletes before the close of entries.

Teams

No Mixed Club Teams are allowed to compete.

The composition of the teams will be taken as they are entered in SurfTec. If a team change is required on the day, please complete the *Team Changes Notification Form* at the end of this Circular and hand to the Tech Recorder/Marshall. Up to 4 changes are permitted per change form with a fee of \$20 which will be invoiced to Club's post event. Note, this form cannot be used to enter new competitors into the Championships.

Final instructions including draws for the events along with the Championship program will be sent out to all competing clubs on Thursday 16 June 2022 and will also be available on SLSWA Surf Sport Team App.
